

Ice Fishing - January 27, 2024

Clothing

To Wear: *(Dress warm and in layers)*

- Waterproof boots *
- Wool socks
- Long pants w/ snowpants over or thermals under. Avoid Levi's.
- Thermal shift or under armor
- Troop hoodie
- Warm winter coat
- Troop beanie or stocking cap
- Warm gloves

Bring With:

- Extra gloves
- Extra socks

* If you do not have waterproof boots, place plastic bags between between your boots and liners - or between your socks and boots.

** If you do not have an ice fishing pole/reel, please let Mr. Nielsen know ASAP so he can work on getting you a pole.

Gear

- Fishing pole & reel **
- Fishing tackle/bait
- Fishing license (if 16 or older)
- Camp chair or 5 gallon bucket (to sit on)
- 3 plastic garbage bags (1 for your fish, 2 for boot liners if needed)
- Pocket knife w/ totin chip
- Water bottle/drink
- Snacks
- Sunscreen
- Permission slip with grub/camp fees

Optional Gear

You can bring the following if you have them, but they are not necessary.

- Ice Auger (manual augers only)
- Sled (to haul your gear out on the ice)
- Fish finder
- Ice shack/shelter
- Hand/Feet warmers
- Sunglasses/goggles
- Foam floor squares (to stand on)
