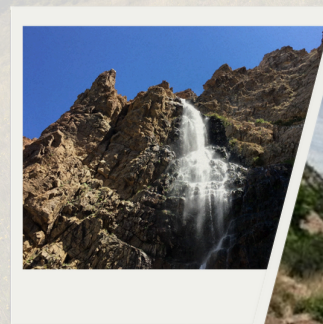
Honoring One of Our Own: Mr. Nielsen, Scouter of the Year 2026
